

# how to make PomPoms

## Materials:

- Cardboard
- Compass or something to make circle shapes
- Scissors and/or xacto knife

## Instructions:



**1-** Trace and cutout 2 donut shapes - you will want these to be about the same size as the finished pom-pom.

Cut out a section on each donut as shown.



**2-** Holding the 2 cardboard pieces together, begin to wrap yarn around as shown. Continue wrapping until the hole is nearly filled in. This took about 150 wraps. If you are making duplicate pom-poms count your wraps so you can make them the same.



**3-** Carefully cut around the edge as shown. You will have to hold the center so the yarn pieces don't come loose.



**4-** Wrap a long strand of yarn around in between the 2 cardboard donuts. Tie, wrapping the yarn around itself twice as shown, pull as tight as you can without breaking the yarn. Then wrap the yarn around the pom-pom again and tie a secure tight square knot.



**5-** It will come out a little bit uneven, so just trim up the scraggly ends until it is nice and round.



The finished pom-pom should be about the same size as the cardboard donuts.
